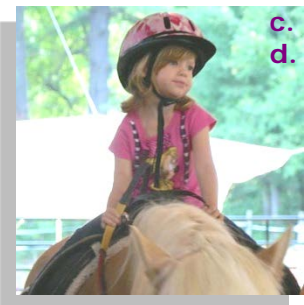

3. Key Hole Race (classes will be divided by riding level based on the number entered) – Take your horse up the center, make a 360° turn and back to start. Sounds easy, but if your horse crosses a pole, you get a 5 second penalty!

**There will be at least one spotter in the arena at all times regardless of the rider's level and ability.**

**We reserve the right to combine classes if there are an insufficient number of riders in a class.**

**Riders will be assigned the horse they usually ride during class.**

**NOTE: On or off lead line does not affect the score unless the leader or spotter has to intervene. This is noted on the score sheet.**

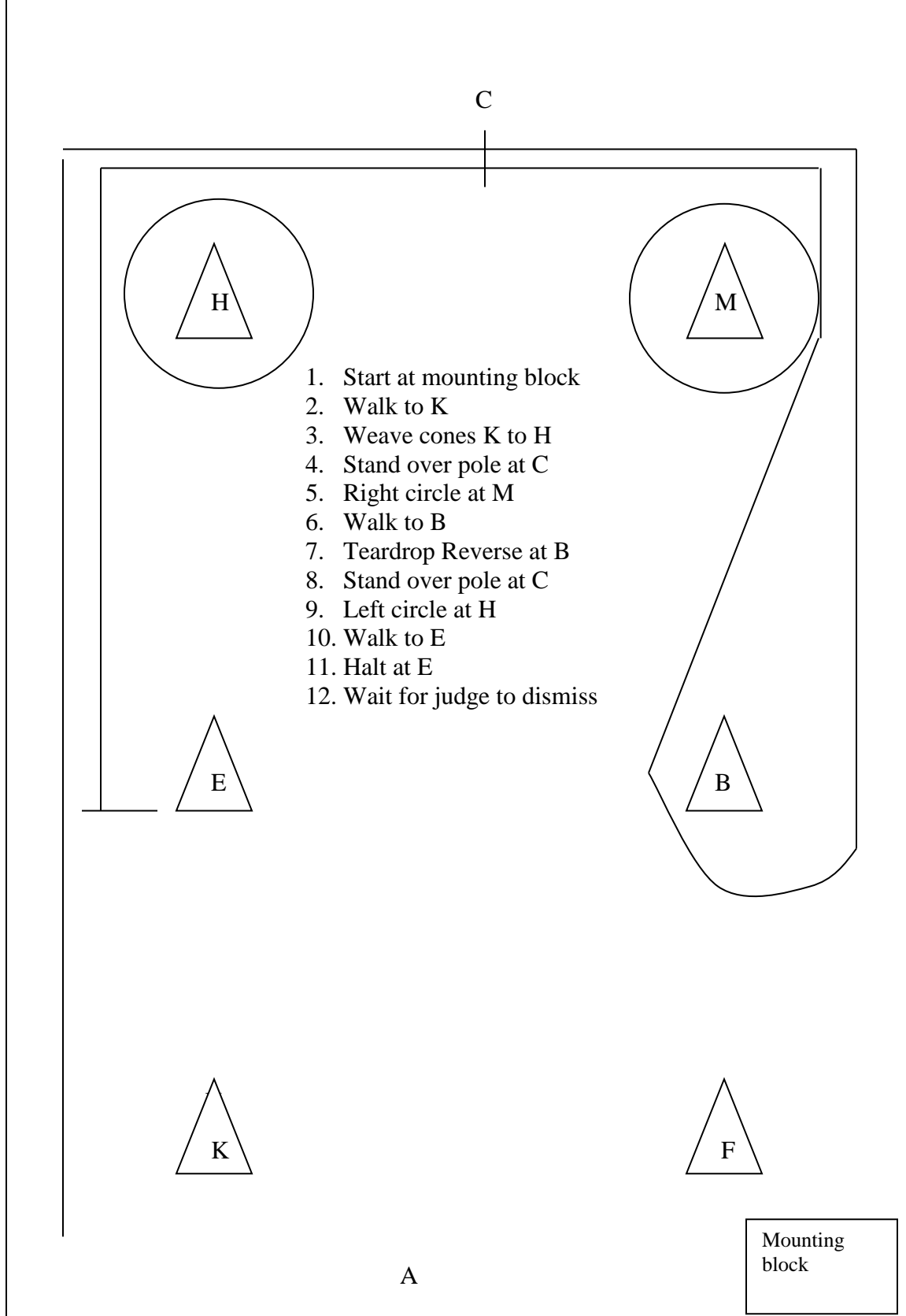

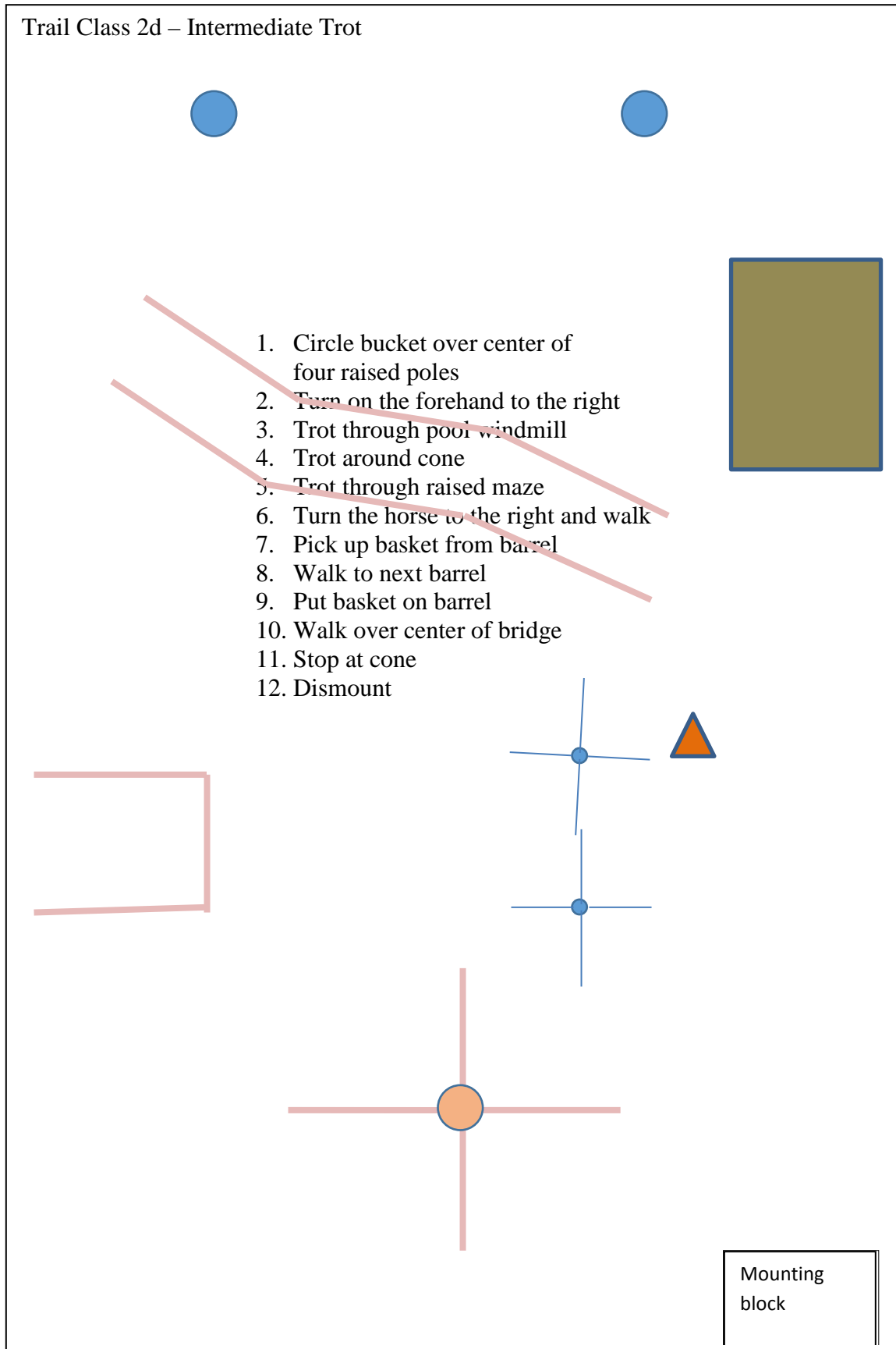

Key Hole Race – same pattern for all levels



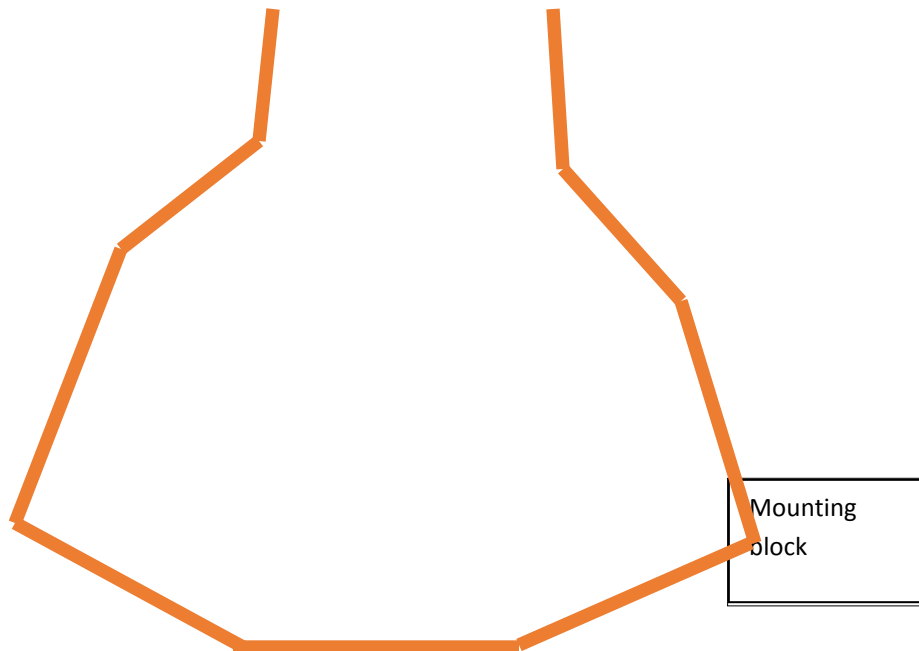
1. Start at the orange cone ( C )
2. Take horse to the circle at the other end of the arena.
3. Turn the horse around – 180<sup>0</sup>.
4. Bring horse back to orange cone ( C )

**This is a timed event.**

Key Hole Race Class 3a walks the entire pattern.

Key Hole Race Class 3b walks the entire pattern off lead line.

Key Hole Race Class 3c trots entire pattern.



Mug shuffle – same pattern for all levels



All Classes

1. Start at the orange cone ( C )
2. Remove the plastic mug from the first pole
3. Put it on the second pole
4. Remove the plastic mug from the third pole
5. Put it on the fourth pole
6. Reverse around the orange cone (A)
7. Bring your horse home



**This is a timed event.**

Class a – stops horse at every pole.

Class b – moves mugs without stopping

Class c – moves mugs without stopping and can trot home.

**NOTE: 5 second penalty if mug drops.**
