3. **Pony Express** (classes will be divided by riding level based on the number entered) – Based on the old Pony Express, the rider will pick up a mail sack near “E” and carry it to “B” where the sack is deposited into a barrel! Classes a and b may stop horse the horse before picking up and dropping the sack.

- a. Walk lead line
- b. Walk no lead line/spotter
- c. Walk – no spotter

4. **Balloon Bop** (classes will be divided by riding level based on the number entered) – Barrels with a cone and balloon makes a star pattern. Rider must ride the star and hit a balloon that is on the barrel with a bean bag. Classes a and b may stop the horse before hitting the balloon. (pattern is in this packet)

- a. Walk lead line
- a. Walk no lead line/spotter
- b. Walk – no spotter

Circle the class(es) the rider will participate in. If there is more than one rider in the family, each rider must complete a separate entry form.

Show information

This is a FUN SHOW. No fancy show clothes are required. This means that the riders can wear their regular riding clothes.

If your child uses one of our helmets, they can still use one of our helmets. Please note, we only have four helmets in each size, so we may have to share between classes.

There is ample seating on both sides of the arena. The back doors will be open and we usually put a hay wagon there for better viewing. There will be room in front of the wagon as well.

Visitors can also sit in front of the viewing room windows. There will be cones set up for the viewing areas.

The RAMP is off limits. Many of our riders need to use the ramp and sitting on the ramp creates an obstacle course for both the riders and the visitors.

LUNCH tickets need to be prepurchased. We provide hamburgers, hot dogs, buns, etc. based on the number of tickets purchased. Please bring a side dish or dessert to share.

Lunch may be eaten outside or in the arena/viewing room.

PARKING!! Stay tuned. We always have enough room, even if we have to park behind the arena. We are not sure when our construction will start, so we will let everyone know at lessons if there will be parking issues. Probably not, but, there might be.

Timing – We try to start promptly at 9:00 am. Starting at 9:00 am means that everyone should be here no later than 8:50. Each rider gets a number for his/her back. Everyone needs to find their seat.

Once we start, the program follows. I can give you an approximate time once I know how many riders we have registered. We try to have lunch around noon. We have stopped the trail class to have lunch when we had 20+ riders one year. I'm thinking about 10 riders this year.

The show ends when it ends. We have never gone past 6:00 pm (that was the 20+ riders show) and have ended by 2:00 pm.

Games start after lunch, so, if we are back in our places within 1 hour after we break, we get done on time or what constitutes on time.

In the event that we have thunderstorms scheduled for the entire day, the show will be held on Sunday, August 11th. That only happened once. It could happen again. If there is only rain, we will ride.

We reserve the right to combine classes if there are an insufficient number of riders in a class.

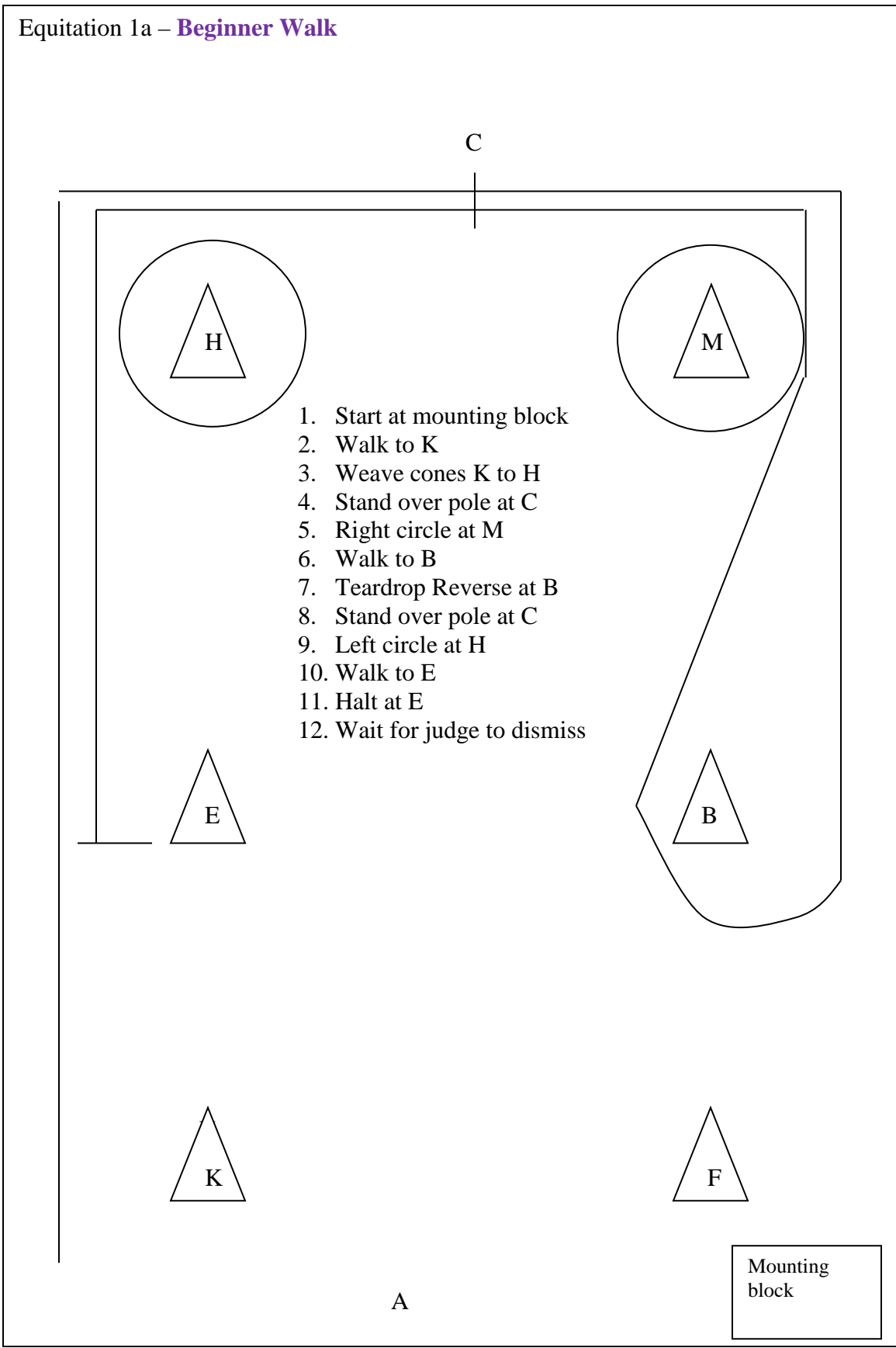
Riders will be assigned the horse they usually ride during class.
